āl hijrah

person or place under special tribal protection; a settlement or community of sādah under tribal protection ibn/bin, pls. abnā' or banī son *jabal*, pl. *jibāl* mountain khurūj rising against unjust rulers madhhab school of law muhajjar under *hijrah* protection *qabīlah*, pl. *qabā 'il* or *qubul* tribe qabīlī, pl. qabā'il tribesman qādī, pl. qudā' hereditary jurist-administrator of tribal descent Catha edulis forsskål. The chewing of this stimulant plant has a qāt history as a social custom in Yemen sayyid, pl. sādah, adj. sayyid male descendant of the Prophet shaykh tribal leader, representative of a tribal unit *`urf*, pl. *a `rāf* tribal customary law *waqf*, pl. *awqāf* religious endowment zaydī, pl. zuyūd, adj. zaydī follower of a branch of Shia Islam whose heartland is in northern Yemen
